## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04R**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WYLIE NORTHEAST SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, WITHDRAWING WYLIE NORTHEAST SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT FROM THE COALITION OF NON-MEMBER CUSTOMERS OF THE NORTH TEXAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT; REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-01R; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Wylie Northeast Special Utility District (the "District") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas created under authority of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and operating pursuant to Chapters 49 and 65 of the Texas Water Code; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2020, the Board of Directors passed Resolution No. 2020-001 authorizing the District to join a coalition of the 34 non-member customers of the North Texas Municipal Water District ("NTMWD"); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager of the District attended a meeting of the NTMWD coalition and informed the Board about matters presented for discussion during the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds the District does not share sufficient common concerns with other non-member customers of NTMWD to remain a member of the coalition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WYLIE NORTHEAST SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT THAT:

SECTION 1. Repeal and Withdrawal. Resolution No. 2020-01R is repealed and the District hereby withdraws from the coalition of non-member customers of the NTMWD.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution hall become effective immediately from and upon its passage.
